Campground Policies

Payment Policy: Full payment is due at time of booking.

Cancel Policy: There is a \$6.00 fee per campsite to change or cancel a reservation 24 hours or more prior to check in (11:00 AM local time). Cancellations within 24 hours of schedule arrival are non-changeable and non-refundable.

Check In: Guests can check in at 11:00 AM or later at the Riley Creek Mercantile or Wilderness Access Center.

Check Out: Check out is by 11:00 AM on your day of departure.

Miscellaneous: All guests staying at Teklanika will require a Camper Bus or Tek Pass. If you require a Tek Pass, or if you are unsure of what type of ticket you require, please call us at 1-866-761-6629 to reserve your ticket.

Shuttle Bus Policies

Payment Policy: Full payment is taken at time of booking

Shuttle Buses / Camper Buses: There is a \$6.00 fee per ticket to change or cancel a reservation 24 hours or more prior to your bus departure. Within 24 hours of bus departure your shuttle tickets are non-changeable and non-refundable.

Check In: Check in at least 30 minutes prior to departure at the Wilderness Access Center (WAC) to pick up your tickets.

Camper Bus Parking Information: There is no overnight parking at the Wilderness Access Center. The best parking option is at the Riley Creek Campground overflow lot located next to the Post Office and Caribou Loop. Across the street from there, the Riley Creek Campground Bus Stop is the first pickup location for the Camper Bus. Overnight parking is also available at the Denali Visitor Center (DVC), Camper Buses will stop at the DVC bus stop after departing the WAC.

Miscellaneous: No food or drink is provided on shuttle buses. Guests are permitted to bring food and drink on board with them. The bus is scheduled to stop for breaks approximately every hour to hour and a half. The Eielson Visitor Center is the only stop that has drinking water (to refill water bottles). No rest stop has food or drink available for purchase.

Tour Bus Policies

Tour Buses: There is a \$6.00 fee per ticket to change or cancel a reservation eight (8) or more days prior to arrival. All changes or cancellations made 7 days or less prior to arrival are non-refundable. Tour Times and Pickup Locations are assigned approximately 24 hours prior to actual tour date.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR TOUR PICK-UP TIME: All tours now depart from the Wilderness Access Center (WAC). There are two general departure times daily: The AM departures leaving generally between 7:10am and 7:30am are designed to get you back for the afternoon train to Fairbanks, while the PM departures allow you to arrive on the noon train from Fairbanks, departing generally between 1:40pm and 2:00pm. Tour Times are assigned approximately 48 hours prior to actual tour date, please arrive at the Wilderness Access Center prior to 7:00am for morning departures or prior to 1:30pm for afternoon departures.

Miscellaneous: Select tours provide a box lunch or snack, however none of the shuttle buses provide food or drink. Guests are permitted to bring food and drink on board with them. The bus is scheduled to stop for breaks approximately every hour to hour and a half. The Eielson Visitor Center is the only stop that has drinking water (to refill water bottles). No rest stop has food or drink available for purchase.
