NOTES

Boyd Lake offers 148 paved pull-through campsites with 20, 30 and 50 amp electricity hook ups. The sites are located on a grassy knoll dotted with trees near the lake. The easily accessible sites can accommodate tents, pick-up campers, trailers and motor homes.

In addition to the camping fee, an entrance fee is required at all state parks!

Shade may be naturally provided by trees and other vegetation or by man made shade shelter. Please call the park for specific details.

DIRECTIONS

One mile east of Loveland. Take Hwy 34 west of I-25; turn north on Madison Avenue and follow the signs.

Campground: May 14 2007 - Dec 31 2050 : CENTRAL RESERVATION OFFICE: 303-470-1144 (Denver metro area) or 1-800-678-2267. The Call Center is open year round Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. The office is closed on weekends and state holidays. A COLORADO STATE PARK PASS IS REQUIRED ON EACH VEHICLE AND IS NOT INCLUDED IN CAMPING FEES. ANNUAL PASS is \$70, VALID FOR ONE YEAR FROM MONTH OF PURCHASE. ASPEN LEAF ANNUAL PASS is \$60 for Colorado residents who are at least 64 years old, VALID FOR ONE YEAR FROM MONTH OF PURCHASE. DAILY VEHICLE PASS \$7 - \$8 PER DAY for entrance to any State Park, depending on the park and time of year you are visiting. Park pass required on each vehicle and does not include camping fees. CANCELLATIONS, TRANSFERS AND REFUNDS Cancellation Policy: If a reservation is cancelled 14 days or more prior to the arrival date, the camping fees will be refunded less the \$10 NON-REFUNDABLE reservation fee and a \$6 cancellation fee. If a reservation is cancelled 13 days or LESS prior to the arrival date, the \$10 reservation fee and the first night's camping fee are NON-REFUNDABLE. Due to the reservation office being closed on weekends and holidays, please try to call far enough in advance for the maximum refund. Change Policy: There will be a \$6 NON-REFUNDABLE transaction fee for any changes made after the initial phone call or Internet reservation. All changes must be made through the Central Reservation Office prior to the arrival date. Campers may not make reservation changes after the date of arrival. All changes must be made within the same park. Internet Reservations: Internet reservations are available to be made or cancelled online at www.cpw.state.co.us 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Internet users accept responsibility for entering accurate information and correct site selection. Any changes must be made through the Central Reservation Office following reservation policies. If you experience difficulties, reservations can be made by phone through the Central Reservation Office during call center hours. Sorry, no refunds will be given for bugs, bad weather, campfire bans or low lake water! CAMPSITE LIMITS Campsite Occupancy Limits: One camping unit with up to six people is allowed per campsite. A violation of this regulation may result in the visitor being required to purchase an additional campsite (if available), or the reservation may be terminated and the reservation and camping fees refunded. A camping unit is defined as the maximum combination of camping equipment allowed in one campsite. The allowable combinations are: One passenger vehicle and two tents; or One motorized vehicle towing a camping trailer and one tent (if space allows). If space permits, one additional passenger vehicle and/or motorcycle may be parked at a campsite. 14-Day Maximum: There is a 14-day maximum stay allowed per park during any 45-day period. This may be 14 consecutive days, or 14 days spread throughout the 45 days. Camp in designated campsites only Keep noise to a low level - At night & on the river Respect private property - Avoid trespassing Keep your vehicle on designated roads - Park in designated areas only Pack out all trash - Please do not litter Keep fires in provided grills - Do not collect firewood Pets must be on a 6' leash Do not feed wildlife Please observe other posted requirements Please print this confirmation letter and take with you to the park.
