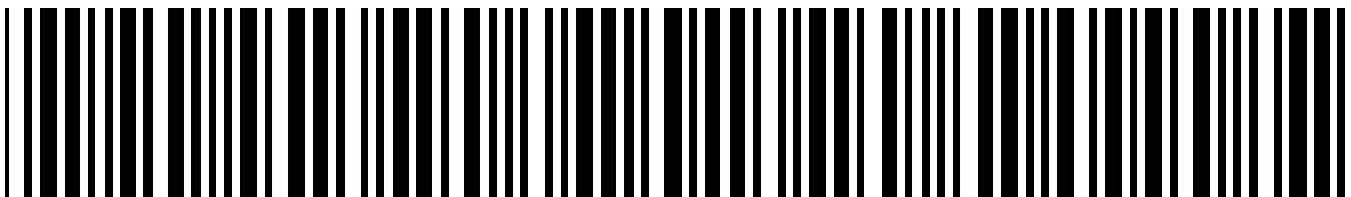

**Changes** - A change is only applicable within the same offer (i.e. you cannot change from a frontcountry campsite to a backcountry campsite/trail or to staying in a Parks Canada accommodation, such as an oTENTik, Yurt, cabin, etc). If you change offers, you would have to make a new reservation:

- Change(s) to your reservation can be made up to 3 days prior to your scheduled day of arrival. A change may include changes in: date(s), campground/accommodation (within the same national park), campsite/accommodation number, etc. You will be charged (or refunded, as applicable) the difference in the value of your stay plus the non-refundable change fee for each transaction.
- If you delay your **arrival date less than 3 days** prior to your scheduled day of arrival; you will be charged (or refunded, as applicable) the difference in the value of your stay, plus the non-refundable change fee plus your first night of camping/accommodations.
- If you change the campground or campsite/accommodation (within the same national park) or departure date at anytime up until 11 a.m. on the day after your scheduled day of arrival ; you will be charged (or refunded, as applicable) the difference in the value of your stay plus the non-refundable change fee.

**Cancellations:**

- If you cancel a reservation at least 3 days prior to your scheduled day of arrival: you will receive a full refund less the original non-refundable reservation fee and the cancellation fee.
- If you cancel a reservation less than 3 days prior to your scheduled day of arrival, but before 11:00 a.m. the day after your scheduled day of arrival: you will receive a full refund less the original non-refundable reservation fee, the cancellation fee, plus the fees for the first night of camping/accommodations.
- If you do not register in the campground before 11:00 a.m. the day after your scheduled day of arrival you will be considered a No Show and your campsite will be released back into the inventory.

• **IMPORTANT INFORMATION:**

- Quiet hours and alcohol restrictions in effect year round, please visit Banff National Park camping website for more information.
- Open fires allowed in designated fire sections or designated shelters only. FIRE BAN in effect 23:00 - 07:00. No open fires allowed in Trailer Court area.
- Maximum Persons per Site: 6 people.
- Maximum Vehicles per Site: 2 vehicles: maximum 1 wheeled camping unit and 1 regular vehicle. We do not permit 2 wheeled camping units on the same site.
- Maximum Camping Units per Site: 2 tents or 1 RV/camper and 1 tent.

• **SPECIAL NOTES AND MESSAGES:**

- Campfires and the consumption of alcohol are not permitted between 11:00pm and 7:00am daily.
- Please don't transport firewood in or out of the park – use local firewood and burn it on site. Pests in your firewood can destroy our forests. (Invasive insects and diseases can exist in firewood. Moving untreated firewood, even just a few kilometres to or from a campground, is a common way for invasive insects and diseases to spread.)
- The selected site is a Walk In Only site and therefore is not accessible by car. You will be required to walk a short distance to access your site.
- A fire permit (for every night of your stay) must be purchased at the time the reservation is created for all reservable sites with fire pits in Banff Tunnel Mountain and Banff Two Jack Campgrounds and will automatically be added to your shopping cart.

• **NATIONAL PARK ENTRY FEES:**
