- Caravans should travel at least 200m apart, so other vehicles including Road Trains, can safely pass.

WAYSIDE INN

Wayside Inns are a little different to roadhouses. They were started, (usually by the station owners) to provide assistance to the early travellers to the region, well before the resorts or national parks were developed. Most have well priced accommodation, camping, bar, store and fuel. They also provide a unique window into the pioneers and the living history of the area.
